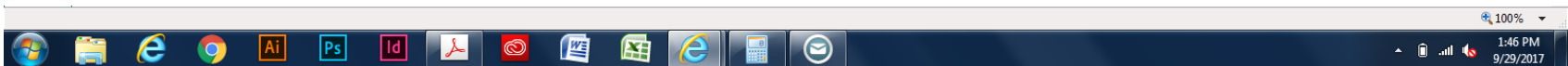


How to Access the Course and Use the Virtual Community

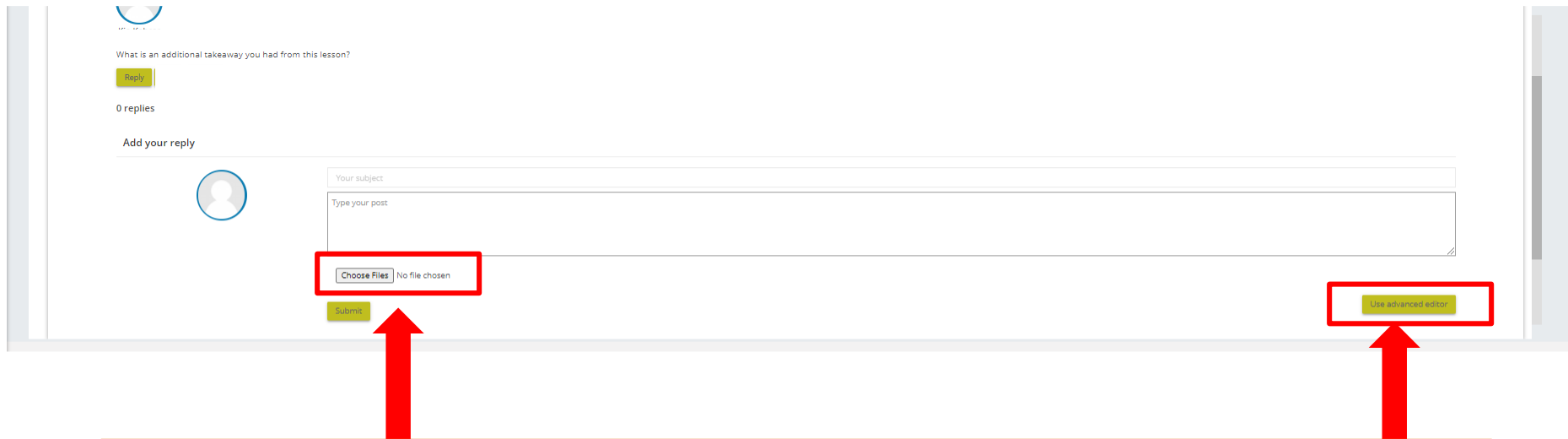
