Role of the Medical Provider on the Multidisciplinary Team

Definition

A medical provider working in the area of child abuse should have foundational training in the area of child abuse and have current licensure commensurate with their education. A medical provider can be:

- A physician (MD or DO), including a pediatrician or child abuse pediatrician (CAP)
- An Advanced Practice Nurse (APRN), including a nurse practitioner (NP) or pediatric nurse practitioner (PNP)
- A Physician's Assistant (PA)
- A Registered Nurse (RN) with additional training as a sexual assault nurse examiner with pediatric training (PSANE or SANE-P)

Definition

A medical provider working in the area of child abuse should have foundational training in the area of child abuse and have current licensure commensurate with their education. A medical provider can be:

- A physician (MD or DO), including a pediatrician or child psychiatrist
- A nurse practitioner (NP), including a nurse practitioner (PNP)
- A mental health professional with additional training as a sexual abuse forensic interviewer (SAFI) or pediatric training (PSANE or similar)
