**Course Description:**

Focus groups are a powerful method for evaluating the experience of a group of individuals, whether it be MDTs, survivors or staff. Information gathered can change how you administer a program, work as a team or understand your organization's impact. If you've never run a focus group but want to learn the basics, this webinar is for you. We will teach you about the approach, when it's most beneficial, and how to conduct it respectfully and ethically. We'll address common concerns around capacity, confidentiality, challenging participants and frequency. Participants will walk away with foundational knowledge about focus groups and how to conduct them.

Kara believes that when done well, evaluation can give voice to underrepresented individuals, empower staff to learn and develop their skills, and change
